Parikshit, Bhavna best

MUMBAI: Bhavan's Parikshit Shetty and Swami Vivekanand's Bhavna Sharma emerged individual boys and girls under-16 champions in the MSSA-Colgate interschool aquatic championships at P.M.Hindu Swimming Bath on Saturday. Shetty, who created new record in the 200 metres individual medley and topped in the 100 metres breast stroke and 100 metres butterfly, aggregated 25 points to top the boys under-16 section. Bhavna won the 200 metres individual medley and was second best in 100 metres butterfly and breast strokes events, with Shi Yen Shu (Bombay Scottish) emerging winner.

BOYS: Under-9: Anukul Shenoy (Sharan English) - 18. Under-11: Sanket Walawalkar (OLPS) - 11. Under-13: Min Kwang Shu (Bombay Scottish) - 21. Under-15: Parikshit Shetty (Bhavan's) - 25.
