Parikshit, Anukul, Ruchi, Shi set new records

MUMBAI: FOUR new meet records were set on the second and concluding day of the Mumbai Schools Sports Association organised and Colgate sponsored 36th Annual Inter-Schools Aquatics Championship at the P M Hindu Swimming pool, Chowpatty, on Saturday.

The two swimmers to set the records in boys category were under-16 individual champion Parikshit Shetty of Bhavan's A H Wadia School, in the 200 metres individual medley; and Anukul Shenoy, of Sharon English, who too emerged champion in his group. Anukul bettered the 50 metres freestyle record.

The other two records which were registered by girls were recorded by under-9 champion swimmer Ruchi Shah, of Lady Vissanji School, in the 50 metres freestyle event and under-16 runner-up Shi Yen Shu, of Bombay Scottish, in the 100 metres breast stroke competition. The under-16 individual championship was claimed by Bhavna Sharma, of Swami Vivekanand, Chembur.
